



## TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF MEMBERSHIP

### 1 MONTHLY MEMBERSHIP

- a) Persons wishing to become members must complete an application form accompanied by payment covering the joining fee and pro-rated monthly membership fee. Subsequent monthly membership fees are payable in advance by Direct Debit. Direct Debit payments will be debited on or just after the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month.
- b) If a membership is cancelled, the joining fee will be payable again on renewal of membership.
- c) If a member does not attend the centre having purchased a membership, they will not be entitled to a refund of membership fees.
- d) CADSART Limited may from time to time increase the fee and tariff due to increases in the costs of overheads or other costs. We will give you at least 3 days written notice of a fee and/or tariff increase. You may end this contract at any time before the increase comes in to effect by giving us 14 days notice in writing.
- e) Members will only be permitted to use the facilities provided your membership is current and fully paid up.

### 2 MEMBERSHIP CARDS

Each member will be issued a membership card, which will remain the property of CADSART Limited and on termination of membership will be returned to CADSART Limited.

Members must present the membership card to reception on each visit to the Club before using the facilities. Any loss of membership cards must be reported to the Club immediately. **There is an administration charge of £3.00 per replacement card.**

### 3 AT HOME MEMBERSHIP

The At Home Membership option allows members to suspend their full membership due to illness, injury or pregnancy at the manager's discretion. A payment of £5 per member per month is payable.

### 4 USE OF EQUIPMENT

In the absence of any negligence or breach of any other legal duty by CADSART Limited, the use by members of any of the company's equipment or facilities is entirely at the member's own risk.

Regular induction classes explaining the safe and proper use of each item of equipment shall be available to members on joining. Induction classes explaining the safe and proper use of each item of equipment must be attended by members intending to use such equipment. The attendance of these classes is the responsibility of the member. The member acknowledges that they must not use any equipment unless they are satisfied that they are competent to do so safely and properly.

### 5 VALUABLES AND LIABILITY

In the absence of any negligence or breach of any other legal duty, CADSART Limited shall not be responsible for or liable to the member for any loss or damage to a member's possessions which are not locked into one of the lockers provided.

The member will not place any combination of items worth more than £100 into a locker.

It is the member's responsibility to check that the locker is properly locked and secure before leaving their possessions in it.

The member will be responsible for any loss or damage to their possessions to the extent that they have not carried out their duty to check and secure the locker used and have placed items worth more than £100 into the locker.

CADSART Limited will be responsible for loss or damage to the member's possession whilst they are in a secured and locked locker, but only if the company has been negligent or breached any other legal duty it has to the member.

### 6 CLOSURES

There will be occasions when it is necessary for CADSART Limited to close its facilities. Such closures are recognised in the level of the membership fee.

### 7 BOOKINGS

Members are advised to book at reception to guarantee their place for a gym or fitness class workout. Members are required to give 48 hours notice if they are unable to attend the session or the current rate for the session/class may be payable.

### 8 GENERAL

CADSART Limited may from time to time change or add to these terms and conditions for security, legal or regulatory reasons. We will give you at least 30 days notice of any changes or additions. You may end this contract at any time before they come into effect by giving us 14 days notice.

### 9 TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP

Membership is for an initial six months contract, thereafter we require two months notice of termination. Notice must be given in writing by a member. In such circumstances it is the member's responsibility to cancel their Direct Debit with the bank.

### 10 USE OF OTHER CADSART LEISURE LIMITED CLUBS

All fully paid up members can make use of the facilities at Neston Recreation Centre and Ellesmere Port Golf Centre.
